# **Preschool Camp**

Pembroke Kids' preschool and kindergarten curriculum features fun-filled activities and academics in a creative, hands-on learning environment. Our 8-week summer camp program runs from 9:00 am to 12:00 pm. Drop-off begins at 8:50 am. Parents must provide a morning snack and beverage each day. Dismissal is at 12:00 noon. Preschool teacher-student ratio is 1:10.

# **School Age Camp**

Explore new ideas, develop new skills, and make new friends in a safe, supportive and fun-filled environment. Our 8-week summer camp program for new kindergarteners and school-age children offers an equal balance of fun and learning that will provide your child with one of the most enjoyable summer experiences possible. A healthy mixture of theme based activities and outdoor fun is part of every day. Our teachers have extensive early childhood experience.

School Age Camp runs from 9:00 am to 3:00 pm. Parents should provide a morning and afternoon snack and a lunch (including beverage). We require the use of an insulated cooler with the camper's name on it. Individual water bottles are encouraged.

## **General Information**

### Registration

Campers are strongly encouraged to sign up for a week at a time but must register for a minimum of 3 camp days per week. The days you pick are flexible. You can pick any 3 or more days in any week(s) you want. We will make every effort to accommodate your requests, but space is filled on a first-come-first-served basis.

## **Extended Care**

Extended Care is available every morning and afternoon for School Age and Kindergarten bound campers only. The Breakfast Club is held from 7:00 am to 8:50 am and features a variety of quiet activities such as board games and arts and crafts. The Fun Club is held from 3:10 pm to 6:00 pm and features both active and quiet games.

## Drop Off and Pickup

Drop off in the morning begins at 8:50 am. Campers who arrive prior to 8:50 am must be dropped off at the Breakfast Club Program. They will be escorted to their appropriate destinations at 9:00 am. Half-day morning pickup is at 12:00 noon. Pickup at the end of the day is at 3:00 pm. Campers who are not picked up by 3:10 pm will be escorted to the Fun Club Program where they can be picked up any time before 6:00 pm. Campers will be charged for the Fun Club after 3:10 pm and the Breakfast Club if dropped off before 8:45 am.

## General Information (cont'd)

## Approved Pickup List

No camper will be permitted to leave Pembroke Kids with anyone other than his or her parent unless camp administrators have been otherwise informed in advance.

#### What to Wear

Campers should wear casual summer clothing such as sneakers, shorts, and a tee-shirt - no sandals, flip flops or Crocs - we'll be running outside! A change of clothing is also recommended. Preschoolers, please apply sunscreen before coming to camp.

#### Snacks and Lunch

Parents should provide a snack for half-day campers and must provide a lunch (including beverages) for full-day campers. We require the use of an insulated cooler with the camper's name on it. Lots of fresh water is always available. Labeled individual water bottles are encouraged. Also, please note: We are a peanut-free and tree nut-free facility.

#### Medical Forms

If you are not currently enrolled in our school, school age campers must fill out ODJFS Child Enrollment Form (JFS 01234) prior to the first day of camp. Preschool and K campers also need ODJFS Medical Form (JFS 01305). These forms can be downloaded from our website, picked up in the school office or mailed. Please contact us if your child has any special medical needs.

#### Prohibited Items

We believe that summer camp is a time for making new friends and building relationships; therefore the use of handheld games, electronics, and iPods is prohibited. We are not responsible for any lost personal items.

#### Termination

Pembroke reserves the right to remove campers from our program for repeated behavioral issues.

## Tuition

You must sign up for a minimum of 3 days per week.

**Preschool-K Camp:** The tuition is \$30 per day. Preschool and Kindergarten Camps are half-day programs only.

**School Age Camp:** Tuition is \$40/full day. We reserve the right to cancel a week's camp for insufficient enrollment.

Extended Care: Mornings in the Breakfast Club costs \$7.00 per day, and afternoons in the Fun Club, costs \$13.00 per day.

**Payments:** A non-refundable \$75 deposit per child is due at registration. There is no registration fee. Tuition balances are due by June 12th. If you sign up for 4 or more weeks, you can pay in 2 installments. Call to make arrangements. Credit card payments are accepted and can be taken over the phone.

**Cancellations:** If you cancel prior to June 12th any tuition paid will be refunded in full, less the deposit. All cancellations made after June 12th will be refunded at 50%, less the deposit.
