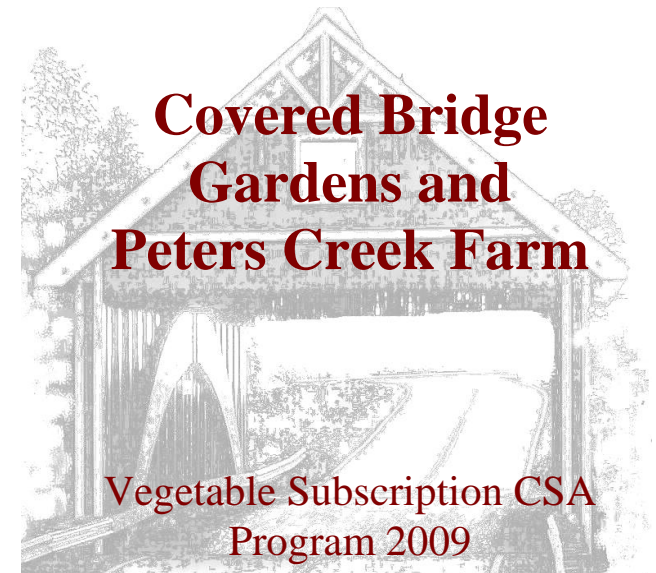
Along with your fresh produce you will receive a newsletter giving you recipes and tips on how to handle, prepare, and preserve the items.
