Teaching Strategies Gold is our new online assessment system for our Preschoolers. Teachers will use this program to plan, instruct, observe, and assess your children. Administration will use the report features of the system to evaluate children's learning and teacher performance. Teaching Strategies Gold will also play a big role in Pembroke's communication to you. Through this new system, you will be able to view documentation shared by teachers, lesson plans, home-school connection activities, newsletters and calendars. Our teachers have been trained and are learning to navigate the system and enter lesson plans and documentation. The next step will be to activate parent portals so that you can access this information. In the next few weeks, you will receive an email invitation from Teaching Strategies at the email address you provided with your technology payment.

At the end of September, we will hold several parent workshops to introduce the features of the parent portal site and how to navigate through it and find pertinent information. 
## School Pictures - Sept. 23 - 25

## Pembroke Offers Tutoring

To help inspire the love of learning in the new school year or minimize academic stress, Pembroke offers one-to-one and group tutoring. Tutoring is available for pre-kindergarten through 8<sup>th</sup> grade. Each student's program is built around their personal needs.
